Our team of qualified and caring clinicians support adults, young people and families to address and recover from alcohol and drug problems through a range of residential and community based programs.

About the Services

Karralika Counselling Services focus on assisting clients toward developing strategies to address alcohol and other drug issues by;

- Supporting positive behavioural change through providing evidenced based therapeutic interventions.
- Providing sensitive, trauma informed care so as to support a clients sense of personal safety in their life and relationships by affirming strengths and resources.
- When appropriate, providing advocacy or assistance in accessing other services.

Community Counselling

Counselling Services

The Community Counselling Program is committed to delivering a high quality, client centered practice to people including families seeking counselling for alcohol and other drug issues and/or co-occurring disorders.

Clients can access AOD counselling which can include crisis support, brief intervention, preparations for entering a residential treatment program, and family relationships including parenting support.

Clients exiting a residential treatment program will have access to counselling that focuses on relapse prevention and community reintegration.

Justice Services Counselling

The program adopts a collaborative approach that acknowledges and supports a person's competence towards finding solutions from their own resources.

The program is committed to increasing access to AOD services people exiting custody, to support those at the risk of recidivism or AOD relapse following release and integration back into the community

Clients eligible for the program will have connections to Justice Services in the ACT (i.e. Community Corrections, Alexander Maconochie Centre).

Clients can create/ fine tune relapse prevention plans, with a focus on thoughts and triggers, high risk situations, selfcheck, goal setting, holistic support structures and assertive behaviours.

As well as focusing on AOD issues, the service can assist clients in addressing anger, anxiety, depression, social isolation, crisis intervention and other issues the client identifies as requiring support with.
